Electric Vehicle Taxi Service


Landour Cantonment Board is an autonomous body under the control of Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence and discharges obligatory and discretionary functions as per the provisions of Cantonment Act, 2006. The functions of the Board are education, public health, sanitation, roads, street lighting, water supply and birth & death registration etc. The various departments of Landour Cantonment Board collectively operate to strengthen the civic infrastructure of the city.

Landour is located at a distance of 35 kms from Dehradun and is a wonderful hill station in Uttarakhand situated at an altitude of 7150ft (2179mts) above the sea level. The highest point of Mussoorie, Lal Tibba is also located in Landour Cantonment from where you can get an exhilarating view of the snow-clad Himalayas and Winter line during the month of November and December every year. Landour is surrounded by thick deodar forests. The nearest railway station is Dehradun and the nearest airport is Jolly Grant in Dehradun.



The lush green hills, the varied flora and fauna and the majestic view of the Shivalik ranges attracts thousands of tourists both domestic and international to Landour each year. In last few years the footfalls have increased to an extent that it is creating traffic woes both for the tourists and local residents. The vehicular pollution is also a big hazard for this quaint place with pristine Himalayan beauty. In order to prevent the environmental damage to this place, it is envisaged to run a dedicated Electric Vehicle Taxi Service from various pick-up points in Mussoorie to Landour Cantonment. This is with aim to prevent the vehicular pollution in Landour Cantonment by establishing a system of promoting Electric Vehicles and managing entry of Non-Electric Vehicles in Landour Cantonment for not only environmental but also archaeological conservation. It is aimed to gradually make Landour, first "only EV accessible Hill Station in India". In this endeavour, we wish to partner with a Private/Government/Semi-Government entity which could contribute in form of capital investment and technological prowess.
